


PASSPORT ISSUANCE

A total of 56,799 passports were issued in the year 2022. An equivalent of 81% of the passports issued during the year were Electronic Passports (32 Pages).

There is a significant increase in number of passports issued during the month of June with 8,537.

Additionally, 796 passport were reported as lost while 51 passports were reported as damged.

AIRPORT MOVEMENT

In 2022, the Maldives received a total of 1,970,830 arrivals. The majority of arrivals were from Velana International Airport, with 1,961,994.

From the total arrivals, 1,675,303 were tourists. Highest contribution came from India with 241,396 tourists.

It was recorded that Maldivians mostly travelled in July (24,799) and December (27,585).

A total of 2,119 foreigners were denied entry at the border and 63 fraud cases were intercepted.





SEAPORT MOVEMENTS

A total of 1,107 vessels arrived to the Maldives during the year 2022. This figure includes 152 tourist vessels and 955 cargo vessels. Majority of these vessels anchored in Male' seaport with a record of 918, while regional seaports served a total of 166 vessels.

Additionally, 2,455 passengers arrived to the Maldives during the year and a total of 16,582 arrived as crew.

There were 2,135 sign-off from vessels and 3,572 sign-on to vessles during the year.

VISA SERVICES

During the year 2022, the majority of the visas were issued to expatriate workers.

The highest number of work visas were issued from Male' (about 97.1%), second to that was Hithadhoo Immigration Office.

A total of 45 employees were blacklisted. Whereas, only 2 employers were blacklisted during the year 2022 for violations related to Immigration matters.

IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT

A total of 432 foreigners were deported from the Maldives in the year 2022.

Expatriate Compliance Division investigated a total of 2,202 cases.

After investigation, 69 foreigners were repatriated as they violated visa regulations. Whereas 90 foreigners were repatriated as they were medically unfit to work in the Maldives.

Among the cases, fines were imposed on 156 sponsors who were responsible for overstay, and 40 foreigners for overstayed.
